AUSTRALIAN FABRIC - Australia makes use of their natural materials in their textile market. Wool and fibers from trees like the Banyan tree have been used to create clothing and fabric.

SILK FROM CHINA - The production of Silk was China's best kept secret. The wife of the Yellow Emperor of China in 3000 BC has been credited with silkworm farming and invented the loom.

RAYON FROM ENGLAND - Rayon was first made and patented in England, in 1894, by chemist, Charles Frederick Cross and his collaborators, Edward John Bevan and Clayton Beadle. This fiber was made from regenerated cellulose fiber. Rayon has been able to imitate the luxurious feel of silk, cotton, wool and linen.

DENIM FROM FRANCE - Denim was made in the French city of Nimes and was called, "serge de Nimes".

LACE FROM EUROPE - The development of Lace has been credited to Europe during the 16th century, giving rise simultaneously to 2 different types of lace—needle and bobbin lace. Lace production flourished in Italy, Flanders and France.
